

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION PRIVACY NOTICE

The new May 25th, 2018 GDPR regulation is to provide you with protection for your identity that did not previously exist in an adequate form.

Hopmog (MSCC South East Centre), by its very nature collects and processes personal data, albeit it on a very small scale, to provide you with the services it offers and to carry out the Club's business. This data, held in whatever form, will be covered by the new act. Therefore, its storage and use is only lawful with your consent. The MSCC has developed an overall plan but each Centre is responsible for its own data and implementation.

The purpose of Hopmog is to foster interest in Morgan cars and to provide opportunities for the use and enjoyment of these vehicles. Consequently, when you complete the annual subscription Hopmog collects personal data from you which is stored on a password protected database. This data is used to provide you with the Club news and events that might be of interest to you.

This use of your personal data is deemed to have been authorised by you when you joined the club and is renewed each year when you renew your subscription. We do not, and never will, divulge your personal information to a third party.

Any person has the right to ask Hopmog to provide a copy of any personal data held about them. This request has to be answered within one month. We will check the identity of the person making the request. Hopmog aims to meet the highest standards when collecting and using personal information. We, therefore, take complaints very seriously. We encourage members to bring to our attention where they think we have collected or used information in an unlawful, unfair, misleading or inappropriate manner.

GDPR provides you with the following rights: - to be informed, to have access to your data, to rectification, to erasure, to restrict processing, to data portability, to object.

Having raised a concern, should you feel that Hopmog has failed to satisfy your issues relating to its processing of your data and wish to raise an official complaint you can contact the Information Commissioner's Office at www.ico.org.uk.

This privacy notice will be kept under review. Should any significantly different use of your data be identified you will be given the opportunity to agree or disagree with such use.

This policy is consistent with MSCC requirements.
